NEXT STEPS

Kitsap Transit completed an extensive alternatives analysis and public outreach process. The Wheaton Way Transit Center project is progressing into the design phase. We are preparing for final design and construction by:

- Gathering community input
- Refining transit center design and layout
- Applying for permits and fulfilling State Environmental Policy Act requirements
- Conducting field work, traffic impact, and noise studies
- Identifying architectural elements
- Pursuing construction funding



A TRANSIT CENTER FOR GROWING NEEDS

Based on needs and growth projections for the Bremerton-Silverdale-Poulsbo corridor, Kitsap Transit proposes building an eight bus bay transit center and approximately 160-stall park and ride on a 4.14 acre site at 3915 Wheaton Way in Bremerton along SR 303. The Wheaton Way Transit Center allows for future growth of public transit operations along Wheaton Way for the next 30-40 years.

The proposed Wheaton Way Transit Center is north of and replaces the current transfer center operated by Kitsap Transit on private property.
