A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE EXPENDITURE FOR INFRASTRUCTURE IMPROVEMENTS TO SUPPORT INDUCTIVE CHARGING INSTALLATION AT

CHARLESTON BASE

WHEREAS, Kitsap Transit is in the design and planning phase for the installation

of ten (10) inductive chargers at the Charleston Base to support electric bus operations;

and

WHEREAS, the installation requires construction of a new transformer, an

underground feeder and an underground primary line extension to provide necessary

electrical infrastructure; and

WHEREAS, these improvements are essential to supporting reliable transit service

and advancing Kitsap Transit's electrification goals; and

WHEREAS, Puget Sound Energy (PSE) has provided a cost estimate of three

hundred twenty thousand nine hundred fourteen dollars (320,914) for the required work

and equipment; and

WHEREAS, funding for the PSE portion of this project will be funded with local

funds as part of our grant match.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED the Board of Commissioners authorizes the

expenditure of funds in the amount of three hundred twenty thousand nine hundred

fourteen dollars (320,914) for the necessary electrical infrastructure improvements at

Kitsap Transit's Charleston Base.
