

RESOLUTION NO. 21-06

A RESOLUTION OF THE KITSAP TRANSIT BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS AUTHORIZING STAFF TO PURCHASE TWO HUNDRED TWENTY THREE UV CATALYST AIR SANITATION SYSTEMS

WHEREAS, the Kitsap Transit Board of Commissioner adopted Resolution No. 20-58, authorizing staff to seek bids for UV Catalyst Sanitation Systems; and

WHEREAS, one bid was received and deemed responsive from United Safety Corporation in the amount of four hundred ninety-nine thousand two hundred thirty-five dollars (\$499,235), plus applicable sales tax; and

WHEREAS, staff is asking to purchase two hundred twenty-three (223) UV Catalyst air purification scrubbers; and

WHEREAS, these sanitation systems will be installed onboard all Routed, *ACCESS* and Worker/Driver coaches in a continued effort to increase the safety and cleanliness of our fleet; and

WHEREAS, funding has been included in the 2021 Capital Budget-Transit Fund in the form of a Washington State grant and local funds; and


NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED the Board of Commissioners hereby authorize and direct the purchase of two hundred and twenty-three (223) UV Catalyst air sanitation systems in the amount of four hundred ninety-nine thousand two hundred thirty-five dollars (\$499,235), plus applicable taxes and fees.
