

RESOLUTION NO. 21-21

A RESOLUTION OF KITSAP TRANSIT BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS TO AMENDING THE SPECIAL SERVICES AGREEMENT WITH THE CITY OF BREMERTON FOR AFTER-HOURS POLICE SERVICES AT THE BREMERTON TRANSPORTATION CENTER (BTC) AND FOR OTHER SERVICES REQUESTED TO INCLUDE ADDITIONAL AFTER-HOURS POLICE SERVICES AT THE WHEATON WAY TRANSIT CENTER

WHEREAS, by Resolution No. 13-68, Kitsap Transit entered into a special services agreement with the City of Bremerton for after-hours police services at the Bremerton Transportation Center (BTC), and for other services requested; and

WHEREAS, the initial term of the special services agreement expired December 31, 2014 and has been extended in subsequent addendums; and

WHEREAS, with Resolution No. 19-104, staff recommended renewing the special services agreement with the City of Bremerton for a period of two (2) years for the period of January 1, 2020 through December 31, 2021 at a rate of pay of seventy-two dollars and eighty-three cents (\$72.83) per hour for services rendered by an officer in an amount of ninety-five thousand dollars (\$95,000) for each year; and

WHEREAS, officer assistance is typically scheduled during peak hours, Monday through Friday at the Bremerton Transportation Center; and

WHEREAS, staff recommends additional after-hours police services to include Wheaton Way Transit Center for the period through December 31, 2021; and

WHEREAS, Kitsap Transit will pay the City of Bremerton for the additional after-hours police services at the Wheaton Way Transit Center at a rate of seventy-two dollars and eighty-three cents (\$72.83) per hour for services rendered by an officer in an amount of ninety-five thousand dollars (\$95,000).

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Commissioners hereby authorize staff to amend the special services agreement with the City of Bremerton for after-hours police services at the Bremerton Transportation Center and for other services requested to include additional after-hours police services at the Wheaton Way Transit Center for an additional ninety-five thousand dollars (\$95,000).
