

RESOLUTION NO. 21-32

A RESOLUTION OF KITSAP TRANSIT BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS AUTHORIZING THE SURPLUS AND SALE OF TWO (2) VANS TO KITSAP COUNTY DEPARTMENT OF HUMAN SERVICES

WHEREAS, Kitsap Transit must periodically surplus vehicles that exceed their useful life or are in excess of current fleet needs; and

WHEREAS, Kitsap Transit’s surplus policy requires that the Board of Commissioners authorizes the surplus of any asset with a fair market value in excess of five hundred dollars (\$500); and

WHEREAS, with proper authorization, staff will typically dispose of the surplus vehicles at auction or direct sale to a third party for fair market value; and

WHEREAS, staff may also elect to transfer, exchange, or otherwise dispose of property to other local governmental entities as may be mutually agreed upon; and

WHEREAS, the Kitsap County Department of Human Services has expressed a need for and interest in purchasing surplus vans to facilitate its services provided in Kitsap County; and

WHEREAS, staff requests authorization to surplus two (2) vans as follows:

WHEREAS, these vans have exceeded their useful life, and similar vehicles have garnered between one thousand five hundred dollars (\$1,500) and four thousand five hundred dollars (\$4,500) at recent auctions; and

WHEREAS, staff requests the Board of Commissioners authorization to sell these two (2) surplus vans to Kitsap County Department of Human Services for one thousand five hundred dollars (\$1,500) each;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED the Board of Commissioners hereby authorizes the surplus and sale of two (2) vans to Kitsap County Department of Human Services in the amount of one thousand five hundred dollars (\$1,500) each.
